Knowledge: Knowing applicable laws, rules & polices as well as the principles of family-centered practice

Understanding: Comprehending the reasons for the laws, rules, policies, & best practices of an ethical, family-centered approach. **Application:** Applying knowledge & understanding to interactions with families in an ethical, family- centered way.

Analysis: Analyzing facts, polices, & ethical considerations to determine responses.

Synthesis: Creating new responses to unfamiliar situations within an ethical framework

Evaluation: Assessing the effectiveness of responses & planning for future improvements
