- ✓ **CLIENTS** served, including the number of adults, children, and families referred and served, demographic information, and the geographic distribution of the clients.

Benefits

Benefits of the Database include:

- ✓ A user-friendly interface.
- ✓ Standardized data collection throughout the state.
- ✓ Reporting functions to generate the information needed in standard reports for funders.
- ✓ The ability to access, track, and monitor clients and services received over time.
- ✓ The minimization of paperwork.
- ✓ The ability to retrieve data to conduct more in-depth analysis on service utilization patterns.
- ✓ Secure storage of data.

Features

There are many important features to the Database, including:

- ✓ It can be accessed via a password-protected login from any computer with internet access at each SV program, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- ✓ Identifying client data is encrypted and stored on a single secure server, protecting it from unauthorized access or local computer problems.
- ✓ Programs only need a web browser (such as Microsoft's Internet Explorer) to access the Database.
- ✓ No local programming or database maintenance is needed.
- ✓ No software update or server maintenance costs for the SV programs.
